### Agenda -1: Submission of proposals under TEQIP Phase-II

<u>Resolution-1:</u> It was resolved that from henceforth all proposals under TEQIP must be submitted at least 20 Days prior to the actual date of upcoming event for smooth approval of the same from all the concerned ITU members and BOG-Chairman.

### Agenda - 2: Systematic Training Need Analysis (TNA)

Resolution 2-a: Nodal Officer-FSD discussed the process of framing TNA through a prescribed format (attached as Annexure-A)

<u>Resolution 2-b</u>: It was resolved that TNA should be linked with the programme objectives. It is also requested to all HODs to consider the curriculum in two parts-core and electives along with a predeployment of subject assignment exercised to be done at department level to frame actual need based analysis.

Resolution 2-c: 50% of the total area of need should be very specific and related to the subject domain. Rest 50% can be kept common for faculty members, to the extent possible for

organizing in house training events. In-House training should preferably be reflected in TNA as well.

Resolution 2-d: It is also resolved that each department will organize a programme at the semester ends, therefore a common training period of 15 days should be kept against all faculty members to enable to attend the same in the coming financial year.

Resolution 2-e: All departmental HODs were advised to depute faculties for a Min. of 2 and Max. Of 4 such short term training other than Conference/Paper presentation in their related subjects, during the academic year 2013-2014.

Resolution 2-f: It was also resolved that department should submit the TNA with a counter signature of HOD at every page of TNA document along with a recommendation through minutes of the meeting of DAC.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
