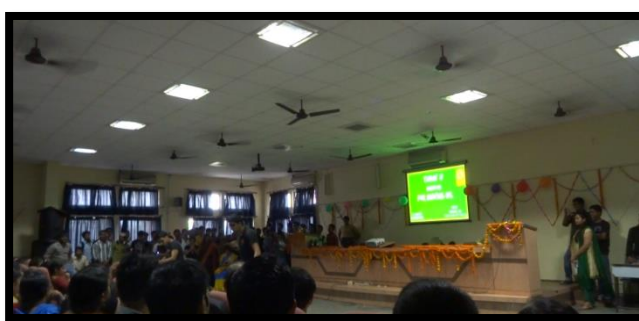
Cultural Program on Teachers Day

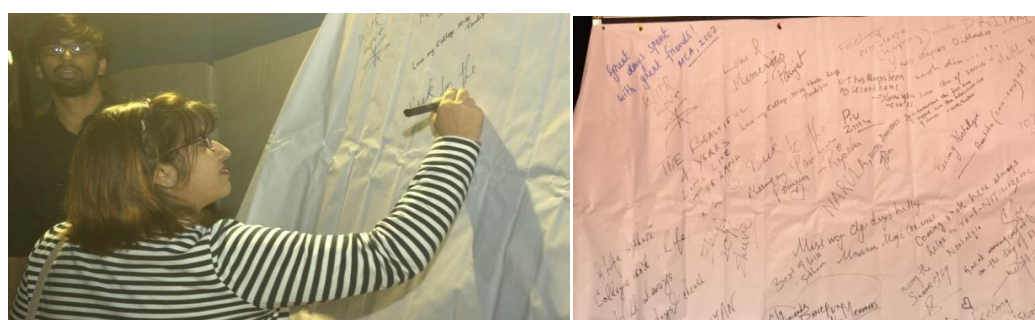

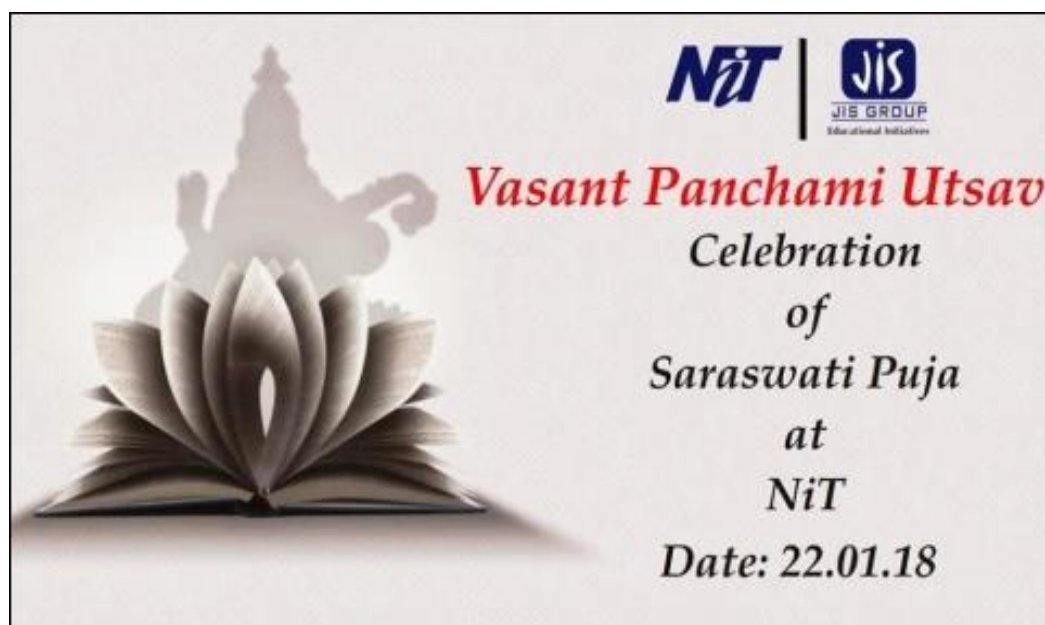

PratimaPoddar ,a 42 year old lady who is Kolkata's first female Mini Bus driver.Mrs.Poddar is a safe driver who supports family after her husband's accident while driving.

RakhiPoddar,daughter of PratimaPoddar,a meritorious student and a pursuing National level gymnast who is fighting all odds and supporting her family.

The Award Ceremony had a special session titled "**Honour The Leaders**" where twelve heads from different schools and three secondary school teachers were honoured for their outstanding contribution towards the student community. This session also witnessed the **felicitation of industry personnels**.
