

# Rabindra Jayanti Celebrated by Department of Civil Engineering


**Date: 8th May, 2020**







Physical Exercise: Jogging, PT, Stretching, etc.


- Rock Climbing: Definition of Rock Climbing, types of climbing, climb down with practical performance □ Rappelling: Long Sling, Shoulder

At the end of the course in Graduation ceremony all students are awarded with certificates.




