OBJECTIVES

o Adherence to the **E-Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011,** as laid down by Ministry of Environment and Forests, for bulk consumers

O Space Management :

End-of-Life and outdated IT products take up huge spaces making it difficult to use these locations effectively.
