INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATE

- 1. Candidates are required to produce the admit card and original registration certificate during examination.
- 2. It is the duty of the examinee to obtain the signature of the Invigilator with date on submission of the written answer script(s) to him/her on each day/half of the examination for theoretical paper.
- 3. Check the question paper is all respect (subject code, subject name, year, semester, category, etc.) before answering the question.
